

Executive Order No. 1446

**Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes**

---

By this Executive Order, I, the undersigned, Governor of the Territory of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by paragraph q of Section 73 of the Hawaiian Organic Act, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

To wit: as a site for the Memorial Park and Natatorium formerly under Governor's Executive Order No. 360, dated June 17, 1929, to be under the control and management of the Board of Public Parks and Recreation of the City and County of Honolulu.

Kaneloa, Waikiki, Honolulu, Oahu

Being all of Lots 101 to 119 (inclusive) of the Kapiolani Park Lots as described in Deed of Sanford B. Dole, President of the Republic of Hawaii to William G. Irwin, dated July 1, 1896 and recorded in Book 184 on Pages 153-159, conveyed to the Territory of Hawaii by William G. Irwin Estate Company by Deed dated July 1, 1919 and recorded in Book 525 on Pages 274-278 (Land Office Deed 1925) and a portion of the underwater area title to which was transferred to the Territory of Hawaii by Presidential Proclamation No. 1856 dated October 27, 1928.

Beginning at the north corner of this parcel of land, the east corner of the City and County Park (Public Baths) and on the southwest side of Kalakaua Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "LEAHI" being 2354.46 feet North and 3282.85 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 3096 and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 347° 22' 30" 350.00 feet along the southwest side of Kalakaua Avenue;
2. 67° 20' 263.54 feet along the land of Kapua (R.P. 5667), L.C.A.W. 5931 Part 1 to Pehu) to the sea-shore at highwater mark;

Thence along the seashore at highwater mark as described in the agreement between the Territory of Hawaii and various Waikiki property owners, dated October 19, 1928 recorded in Book 1047 on Pages 176-202. (Land Office Deed 3774) the direct azimuths and distances between points on said seashore being:

3. 171° 31' 0.12 feet;
4. 164° 00' 150.70 feet;
5. 161° 30' 112.00 feet;
6. 77° 28' 252.10 feet;
7. 122° 47' 21.60 feet;
8. 167° 02' 352.50 feet;
9. 211° 42' 21.60 feet;
10. 256° 29' 245.60 feet;
11. 166° 42' 36.00 feet;
12. 157° 35' 108.70 feet;
13. 159° 58' 37.00 feet;
14. 166° 27' 169.40 feet; thence
15. 257° 18' 314.43 feet along the Public Baths to the point of beginning.
